

Bind It All Desk Calendar

Here's a quick, easy calendar to make as a gift or keep for yourself. And, best of all...it's a chance to recycle and use up your scraps.

Gather your materials. You will need the following items to complete this project.

Tools:

- 12 inch Rotary Trimmer
- Zutter Bind It All
- Zutter Wire Cutters
- 12 inch ruler
- Sizzix with Flower Dies
- Paper Piercer
- Paper Distress Tool
- Scissors
- Prima Build A Swirl Stamp

Supplies:

- One Zutter 12 inch 3/4 inch diameter O-Wire(or three six loop sections): Silver
- Prima Regal Sunset Card stock
- Prima flowers, burlap and cardboard from Donna Salazar's Down Home Collection
- Ranger Distress Ink: Faded Jeans, SnowCap, Vintage Photo
- Staz On: Azure
- White Card stock
- Making Memories Brads

Before starting, remember: Measure twice, cut once.

Use an empty plastic flat package to cut out three (3) 6 x 4 inch clear acrylic pieces. Center two of the pieces in the BIA and punch six holes. Bend third piece in half, center and punch six holes.

Cut six 3 ½ x 4 inch pieces of patterned card stock. Use scissors to scallop the bottom. Find an on line free calendar for 2009 and print it on white card stock. Mine fit on one 8.8 x 11 inch piece. Then cut out the individual months into 2 x 2 ½ inch pieces, and distress the edges with distress tool and ink. Glue each month to the center of card stock ½ up from the peak in the scallop at the bottom. Glue two months per piece of card stock (i.e. January/February; March/April; May/June; July/August, etc).

Place the six pages into the BIA with the earliest month on each piece facing the turning knob on the BIA. Only slide the pages in far enough to punch four holes on the extreme side.

Assemble calendar with the card stock pages on one side with the punch holes toward the center of the 4 x 6 inch acrylic. Bind to side pages together at the top and bind each side page to the folded middle page at the bottom.

Peel surface of cardboard off of Prima 4 x 6 frame, buttons, and hearts. Paint both sides with crackle

paint. Cut frame in half. Attach each half to inside of each acrylic side with Aleene's Paper Glaze. Cut flower shapes from burlap & paint with Glimmer Mist. Embellish sides of acrylic with these plus Prima flowers, burlap, textiles and ribbon, and MM brads.

Bind It All Acrylic Postcard Album

I recently participated in a postcard swap with eighteen individuals in the scrapping community from all around the world. The beautiful cards and heartfelt, handwritten sentiments are very special to me. I needed a very special way to showcase these treasures. What better way than an acrylic album? Here the emphasis is on those postcards, so minimal materials are needed. But the impact is stunning. This would make a great way to showcase a special trip too.

Gather your materials. You will need the following items to complete this project.

Tools:

- 12 inch Rotary Trimmer
- Zutter Bind It All
- Zutter Pound It All
- Zutter Punch and Hammer
- Dymo Label Maker
- Fancy Pants Stamps
- Clear Drying Adhesive
- Adhesive Tape Runner
- Fiskars Threading Water Border Punch
- Making Memories Alpha Punch Set

Supplies:

- Two (2) Sets Zutter Acrylic 5x7 Tabbed Pages
- One Zutter 12 inch 1 1/4 inch diameter O-Wire: Black
- One Zutter Perfect Closure
- Teresa Collins Travelogue Patterned Paper
- One 8 1/2x11 inch sheet of Black Card stock
- Reminiscence Rub-ons
- Ranger Paint Dabber
- Fancy Pants Chipboard
- WestRim Bling
- Staz On: Jet Black, Red
- Miscellaneous Chain & Key

Before starting, remember: Measure twice, cut once.

Add up the number of Post Cards you have. Cut that number (times 2) of 1 1/4 x 5 inch black card stock. Glue one on the front left and back right of each postcard. Capture as little of the actual postcard as possible to hold it.

Cut the same number of patterned paper pieces sized 1 x 5 inches. Use the Fiskars Border Punch on one edge. Glue one on the front left and back right of each piece of black card stock.

Stamp on one side of each acrylic tab page with Black Staz On. Create labels for the tabs in your book with the Dymo Label Maker. Attach these to the tabs.

Place the postcards in the BIA with the card stock & patterned paper border in the machine. Center and punch six holes. Center the acrylic pages and punch six holes. Cut out a tag from the Teresa Collins Paper and label. Glue to inside of front cover, facing out.

Color Perfect Closure with Staz On: Red. Stamp the word "Journey" into the leather.

Bind book, attach bling and chain with key. Attach the Perfect Closure. Enjoy.

Bind It All 3x4 Cover-All Journal

A quick project for a small journal to carry important information, jot notes or use in any other fashion you can think of.

Gather your materials. You will need the following items to complete this project.

Tools:

- Zutter Bind It All
- Zutter Pound It All
- Zutter Punch and Hammer
- Adhesive Tape Runner
- Paper Tearing Tool
- Ranger Distress Ink: Vintage Photo

Supplies:

- One Zutter 3x4 Inch Cover-All
- One Set Zutter 4x4 Inner Pages: Cream
- One Zutter 12 inch 3/4 inch diameter O-Wire: Antique Brass
- Zutter Brass Rivets
- Trimz Ribbon
- Fancy Pants Chipboard
- Kaiser Kraft Patterned Paper, Pearls
- Studio G Stamp
- Prima Flowers
- Miscellaneous Colored Paper Clips
- Glimmer Mist: Autumn Leaves

Before starting, remember: Measure twice, cut once.

Spray Cover-All liberally with Glimmer Mist, inside and out. Let blotches and puddles remain...it adds

to the character!

Tear patterned paper to slightly less than 3x4 inches for front and rear covers. Then tear two pieces even smaller for inside those.

Stamp chipboard with word. Adhere papers and chipboard to Cover-All. Embellish with Prima flowers with rivet centers, and Trimz.

Rivet Trimz to book spine.

Cut 4x4 inner pages to 2 ½ x 3 ¾ inches. Assemble journal per instructions for Cover-All.

Bind It All 8x8 Cover-All

A memory album for 2008. I wanted an album that I could put the highlights of 2008 into. Something to use up lots of scraps and tons of flowers.

Gather your materials. You will need the following items to complete this project.

Tools:

- Zutter Bind It All
- Zutter Pound It All
- Zutter Punch and Hammer
- Adhesive Tape Runner
- Paper Tearing Tool
- Steel Ruler
- Accucut & Heart Album and Small Heart Dies (B1544J & H1242S)
- Quik Kutz Revolution & Hearts Embossing Folder
- Dymo Label Maker
- Craft knife
- Ranger Distress Ink: Vintage Photo
- Ranger Stickles: Crystal

Supplies:

- One Zutter 8x8 Inch, Bamboo Spine, Cover-All
- One Set Zutter 8x8 Inner Pages: White
- One Set Zutter 8x8 Acrylic Covers
- One Zutter 12 inch 1 inch diameter O-Wire: Black
- Zutter Rivets
- Zutter Perfect Closure
- Bo Bunny Patterned Paper, Ribbon, Brads, Card Stock Stickers
- Cosmo Cricket Rub-ons
- Fancy Pants & Miscellaneous Chipboard
- Making Memories Metal
- Making Memories Brads
- Prima Flowers
- Doodle Bugs & Miscellaneous Buttons

- Kaiser Kraft Felt Borders
- Me and My Big Ideas Icons Bling
- Glimmer Mist: Pink Taffy

Before starting, remember: Measure twice, cut once.

Spray Cover-All liberally with Glimmer Mist, inside and out. Let blotches and puddles remain...it adds to the character!

Use AccuCut Heart Album Die to cut a hole in the Cover-All front. Decorate Front and rear (outside) of Cover-All in torn pieces of patterned paper (of various sizes); card stock stickers; flowers with brads and bling for centers and ribbon. Use a craft knife to cut out the heart opening on the front where it covers the opening. Cut a transparent overlay to fit over the inside of the heart shape. Place on inside cover with patterned paper. Decorate inside covers with paper pieces, flowers with brads and bling centers and card stock stickers.

Use an acrylic cover as the first inner page. Decorate the Heart cut out of the cover with patterned paper, buttons, mini hearts. Cut MM aluminum into heart with small heart die. Emboss with Cuttlebug Hearts Embossing folder. Paint with black paint. When dry sand off the top paint. Adhere metal heart to cut out.

Decorate remaining 8x8 white inner pages with patterned paper, flowers, buttons, metallic thread, card stock stickers, brads, felt, stickles and journaling labels.

Assemble journal per instructions for Cover-All. Rivet the heart cover cut out to acrylic first page. Ink Perfect Closure with Red Staz On. Stamp "Private" on the leather. Install it on Cover-All.
